Cat Adoption Program...a Great Deal!

Downey, Calif The Southeast Area Animal Control Authority (SEAACA) in Downey is making one last push to get their cats into good homes this summer season. In place are two programs designed to increase kitty placements – Cat Days of Summer, a program where all cats cost only \$25.00 to adopt. The reduced fee includes spay/neuter, 1st. set of vaccinations, de-worming a microchip and of course, the kitty. The second program is the Summer Buddies program, instituted by Found Animals Foundation out of Los Angeles. “This is essentially an adopt one get one free program running concurrently with our in-house summer program,” said Dan Morrison, Executive Director for SEAACA. “Adopters can bring two cats into their family, with all the bells and whistles, for only \$25.00.” Morrison said.

“We haven’t officially tallied the results thus far, but we know that cat adoptions went from single digit to double digit totals on an almost daily basis this summer.” Morrison said. SEAACA adopted 175 cats in July, 2009 compared to 130 cats in July, 2008. Only the Cat Days of Summer program was in place in 2008. Both programs are set to conclude at SEAACA on August 29th, so the animal care agency is making a last ditched effort to place as many cats as possible at the reduced pricing and “second cat free” offers. “It’s a wonderful value, and saves lives,” said Morrison.
